RULES OF BEHAVIOUR FOR THE ROOFTOP

OUT OF SIGHT OUT OF MIND? PLEASE NOT!

Please collect your waste after each use and dispose it immediately. Everything you carry upstairs must be taken back down. The rooftop is supposed to leave a neat and clean impression.

DUMP OLD FURNITURE ON THE ROOFTOP? NO, BRING IT STRAIGHT TO THE RECYCLING YARD "HAGENHOLZ".

Only garden furniture is allowed on the rooftop. That is, furniture which is weatherproof and clearly declared as garden furniture. Furniture with cushion covers such as sofas and armchairs of any kind, mattresses, carpets, etc. are not allowed. Cushions and recliners must be removed after use and stored in your apartment or in your basement. **Defective furniture must be disposed immediately.** All pieces of furniture remain in your own basement compartment over winter.

HIDING FROM THE SUN

Sunshades are allowed, but must be retracted and taken down after use. At this altitude, wind gusts are stronger and there is a high risk of the umbrellas being blown off the roof, causing damage to property or harm to persons.

COMMUNICATION TROUGH SMOKE SIGNALS? NOT ON THE ROOFTOP!

For fire safety reasons, both lighting fires

and grilling (regardless of the type of grill) are prohibited on the rooftop.

CAUTION WITH PLANTS

Frequent watering often leads to water damage on the terrace. If the plants get too little water - they may wither and make a bad impression.

INDULGE INTO THE SUNSET WITH MUSIC? SURE, BUT WITHOUT ANY NOISE COMPLAINTS.

A reasonable volume is required, as you do not live alone in the house. We expect appropriate respectful behaviour: Think of your surroundings and adhere to the night rest from 22 p.m. to 07 a.m. and all day on Sundays and public holidays.
