

Tips for living together in harmony

As the Rolling Stones told us: “You can’t always get what you want” – and living together in a house requires give and take. Here are a few rules:

- **First impressions count – introduce yourself to your neighbours**
A good relationship with your neighbours will be helpful for you in all kinds of situations. If your moving-in party was too loud or if you accidentally washed your laundry on the wrong day, your housemates will be more forgiving if you have a good relationship with them.
- **Speech is silver, silence is golden? We prefer the opposite...** Does your neighbour walk around in their apartment late at night wearing shoes? Or does he/she take a shower every evening at 11 p.m.? Then speak to him/her directly.
- **The washing machine – a perpetual mystery**

- **Sleep is for old people... Or is it?**
Remember that not everyone in the building is a Juwo tenant. And that they also need to sleep. Therefore, please observe the **quiet hours from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.**, and all day on **Sundays and public holidays**. This means any activities that make a noise, including listening to music, using the vacuum cleaner and doing laundry – this also means you have enough time to sleep and recover from late nights (or to study, if applicable).
- **Do your vegetables in the fridge look more like a block of ice? Or does the heating cause problems for you all through the night?**

- **Have you completed your studies? Or are more than 30 years old?** Please respect our rental criteria, thanks to which you can/were able to rent at a reasonable price, and inform us immediately.
